



IMPORTANT OBSERVATIONS REGARDING TOXOPLASMA SEROLOGY:

- Positive reactions are easier to identify in early pregnancy tests.
- Serocoverison is defined by the presence of IgG and IgM: it should be confirmed as soon as possible with a 3rd Sampling.
- It takes about 3 weeks between the two samplings to confirm the stability of the IgG bond; however, sometimes, 10 to 15 days can suffice to evidence its increase.
- The presence of IgM is rare in cases of reactivation.
- Administering an antibiotic treatment soon after the infection may attenuate the humoral response.
- It may be necessary to search for clinical signs and to use complementary techniques (differential agglutination, IgA screening...) in order to specify the time of infection.

PND: Prenatal Diagnosis.

*In rare cases of primary infections, the surfacing of IgG may be delayed for a period of 3 weeks.
